persuade, appeal to, to convince someone to believe someone and to act accordingly

πεφανερώμεθα PfPI1pl fr. φανερωω

πεφανερῶσθαι PfPIInf
reveal, make known – of a person, pass. be made known, be known, cause something to be fully known pass. be fully known

συνειδήσεις

moral consciousness, conscience, the faculty which can distinguish right & wrong, moral sensitivity

φόβον

that which causes fear, respect or reverence, profound respect & awe for deity

v. 12

συνιστάνομεν PAI1pl fr. συνιστημι
present, introduce, or recommend someone to someone else, cf. Rom. 5:8, to indicate approval of a person or event with the implication that others adopt the same attitude

ἀφορμῆν

opportunity, pretext, foundation on which to build a set of circumstances favorable for a particular activity or endeavor, occasion

καυχήματος

boast, what is said in boasting

καυχώμενους PdepPtcpMPA fr. καυχαομαι

to boast, glory, pride oneself in something, pride self on externals

προσώπῳ

external things, appearance, as seen

v. 13

ἐξέστημεν AAI1pl fr. ἐξιστημι
drive out of senses, confuse, lose ones mind, be insane, be irrational

σωφρονοῦμεν PAI1pl fr. σωφρονεω

be of sound mind, be sane, think correctly

v. 14

συνέχει ΠΑΙ3sg fr. συνεχω
urge on, impel, but hold within bounds, control, to exercise control over something

κρίναντας ΑΑΡτсрMPA fr. κρινω
judge, think, consider with τουτο ότι - have or hold a view or opinion, regard

ὑπὲρ
in place of, instead of, in behalf of, for the sake of, marker of participant who is benefited
or on whose behalf an event takes place

ἄρα
in the apodosis of conditional sentences to emphasize the result, then, as a result, marker
of result as inference from what precedes
