## John 3:16-18 Teaching Outline

- I. God has given His Son to save
  - A. God loved the World in this certain way
  - B. The Result: He gave His Son to save the world
    - 1. General: He gave His Son that those who believe are saved
      - a. He gave His Son
      - b. Those who believe are saved
        - i. Neg.: Those who believe shall not perish
        - ii. Pos.: Those who believe shall have eternal life
    - 2. Specific: He sent His Son for the purpose of saving those who believe
      - a. Neg.: He did not send to condemn
        - i. He did not send His Son into the world
        - ii. For the purpose of condemning the world
      - b. Pos.: He sent His Son to save
        - i. [He sent His Son]
        - ii. For the purpose of saving the world through Him
- II. The Implication: Those who believe in the Son are saved
  - A. Pos.: Those who believe in Him are not condemned
  - B. Neg.: Those who don't believe are condemned
    - 1. Those who don't believe stand condemned already
    - 2. Reason: Because they have not believed in the Name of God's One & Only Son
