

## Gal. 3:15-18

<sup>15</sup>. Brothers, I am speaking according to human standards, even so, when a human will has been validated, no one invalidates it or modifies it [without proper legal recourse]. <sup>16</sup>. The promise was said to Abraham and to his descendant. It does not say “to his descendants” as spoken to many, but as spoken to one it says “to your descendant” – who is Christ. <sup>17</sup>. I am saying this – the Law, coming into existence after 430 years, does not void the covenant, which was validated by God, so that it invalidates the promise. <sup>18</sup>. Because, if the inheritance comes from Law, then it is no longer from promise. But God graciously granted [the inheritance] to Abraham through promise.
